

**RESOLUTION OPTING OUT OF REQUIREMENTS  
OF MINNESOTA STATUTE SECTION 462.3593  
CITY OF EAST GULL LAKE  
COUNTY OF CASS  
RESOLUTION 08:02-16**

Pursuant to due call and notice thereof, a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of East Gull Lake, County of Cass, Minnesota, held on 2nd day of August, 2016, at 6:30 p.m. The following resolution was introduced and Council moved upon its adoption:

**WHEREAS**, the State of Minnesota recently adopted and enacted Minnesota Statute Section 462.3593 relating to temporary family health care dwellings, which allows the issuance of a permit for such dwellings, and allows cities to opt out of the requirements of said statute; and,

**WHEREAS**, The City Council of the City has determined that it needs time to study the appropriateness of temporary family health care dwellings within the City; and,

**WHEREAS**, the City's Planning Commission should study the issue of temporary family health care dwellings to determine if they are appropriate within the City, and if so, where they should be located, the size of the structures, setbacks and other issues associated with temporary family health care dwellings; and,

**WHEREAS**, if the City determines that temporary health care dwellings are appropriate within the City, the City should amend its zoning ordinance accordingly.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the City of East Gull Lake opts out of the requirements of Minnesota Statute Section 462.3593.


Adopted by the Council this 2<sup>nd</sup> day of August, 2016.
